Each of the following sponsorship levels has been designed to give our sponsors the highest value for their contribution to PCBFA's operations.

Platinum Sponsor

\$1,750

Up to \$4,250 advertising value

Platinum level corporate sponsors receive continuous recognition in our monthly newsletter, have their logo on our website for the year, and receive recognition through PCBFA events, projects, and social media. Gold Sponsors are also invited to send a representative and set up a booth at a maximum of one PCBFA event per year (value \$250).

Silver Sponsor

Promotion for individual events up to \$1,550 value

A silver sponsor is recognized at an individual event. The sponsor is invited to give a 30-minute presentation at the event (value \$800) as well as have a booth set up with any hand-outs, advertising or products they wish to share (value \$250). Their logo will be included on any advertising, agendas or other handouts for that event (value \$500).

Bronze Sponsor

Promotion for individual events up to \$500 value

A bronze sponsor is recognized at an individual event. Either the event will be hosted as an in-person workshop or a live stream webinar. The sponsor is given two options depending on the workshop format:

- In-person workshop the sponsor is invited to provide a 15-minute review of their product or service midway through the event. The funds provided by the bronze sponsor will be used to provide all attendees of the event with coffee and snacks. Their logo will appear on all print materials, including advertising and any handouts (value \$500)
- Live stream webinar the sponsor is invited to provide a 15-minute review of their product or service midway through the event. Their logo will be included on all advertising for the event (Alberta-wide audience) and will be included on a banner during the livestream webinar (value \$500).
